Inaugural Global Scholarship Policy

This policy is direct related to the Student Fees Policy.

1.0 Inaugural Global Scholarship (2026)

The aim of our **Inaugural Global Scholarship**, in celebrating our launch, is to help attract international students to our new institution, and give a global community to our student body, making the experience richer for all students.

1.1 The scholarship is automatically awarded to eligible students as a fee reduction on each year's tuition fee.

2.0 Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for an **Inaugural Global Scholarship**, you must:

- be classified as an international fee-paying student
- be self-funded or partially self-funded
- hold a conditional or unconditional offer for a course starting in September 2026
- accept your offer by your given deadline
- pay your deposit by given deadline
- be entering into year 1 of your course
- meet all conditions set out in the offer letter

3.0 How to apply

You do not need to submit a scholarship application. If you meet the eligibility criteria, you will automatically receive this scholarship offer. You must then accept and pay deposit by given deadlines.

4.0 Receiving the Scholarship

Your 'Offer Letter' will include details of this scholarship, if you are eligible.

The scholarship is a tuition fee discount which will be deducted from your full tuition fee when you register as a student at ASU London.

This scholarship cannot be deferred to a future year.

5.0 Purpose and Scope

This document outlines the eligibility criteria for International fee paying students commencing studies in September 2026 to receive scholarships from ASU London. This policy is correct at the time of publishing (January 2026) but may be subject to change.

The scholarship award criteria can be found at the top of this document.

The scholarship is subject to the terms and conditions set out in this document.

6.0 Accepting your Scholarship

- In order to access the scholarship you must 'accept' your offer and pay your deposit by the given deadlines.
- You must enrol at ASU London.
- The scholarship award **cannot be deferred** to the following year and is only transferable to other eligible courses at ASU London.
- This scholarship is paid as a fee reduction for each year of study and can only be used as a fee reduction. It **cannot be used** towards other costs, including but not exclusive to maintenance or accommodation costs.

7.0 In order to continue receiving your Scholarship:

- You must maintain attendance at 80% or above throughout your course.
- You must maintain an average of an upper second-class honours.
- You must not be repeating or retaking a module.
- You must not be considered to be in debt to ASU London.

8.0 Terms and conditions

8.1 General

8.1.1 ASU London reserves the right to terminate a scholarship where a student is in breach of any of these terms and conditions, or, if any information provided to ASU London as part of their application is found to be false or misleading. In such circumstances, the student will be liable for any tuition fees incurred.

8.1.2 ASU London reserves the right to limit the number of awards of scholarship.

8.1.3 Where a limited number of awards are available, the award allocation may be conducted on a first come first served basis. In such cases the scholarship scheme will be closed without notice once all awards are accepted.

8.2 Approving and Awarding of Scholarships

8.2.1 Scholarships are a discount made against the tuition fee applicable to the specific programme of study that the student is seeking to enrol upon. No cash or cost of living alternative is available.

8.2.2 If a scholarship has been awarded, the fee discount will be applied to the student's tuition fee liability.

8.2.3 The scholarship will normally be applied across the tuition fee in 3 instalments, if the student is paying their fees in 3 instalments or a single instalment applies if the balance is settled in full.

8.2.4 Students who are repeating any modules within the programme are not eligible for scholarships regardless of whether they are repeating with attendance, without attendance, or with partial attendance.

8.2.5 Where a student interrupts their studies and takes a Leave of Absence for a complete academic year (i.e. September to September) no tuition fee is charged and, therefore, the student will not be eligible to receive a scholarship.

8.2.6 Students who interrupt their studies part way through an academic year and take a Leave of Absence will be eligible to receive a scholarship for the academic terms they have completed in full. The amount of the scholarship will be calculated on a pro rata basis and in line with ASU London Student Fees Policy.

8.2.7 ASU London reserves the right to amend, create or withdraw scholarships throughout the year.
